



Sixth Form Application FAQ

Q. Who should complete the application?

A. The applicant (student) should complete the application but it is recommended that a parent/carer is present or reviews the application before submitting.

Q. How many subjects should I apply for?

A. The majority of students will take 3 Level 3 Courses, a small number of students do take 4 which is discussed during interview. All students are welcome to list a reserve subject.

Q. Who should write my reference and what should it include?

A. You must name a teacher or tutor in the Education section of the application form who will receive an automated email to complete a reference for you.

Q. What should I include in my personal statement?

A. The personal statement is a maximum of 350 words and should include reference to:

- Why you would like to come to Rushcliffe Sixth Form
- The subjects you are applying to study and why
- Your future ambitions (if known) – university / apprenticeship / career
- Extra curricular commitments and interests

Q. What is the next stage of the application process?

A. Rushcliffe Spencer students will be interviewed in the next half term. New to Rushcliffe Students will be invited to attend a New to Rushcliffe evening where interviews take place. These events are calendared for 10th & 23rd February.

Q. What is the deadline for applications?

A. Applications must be completed by 4pm on Monday 6th December 2021.
